This Privacy Notice describes how Alpha Security Bureau collects, uses, protects, and safeguards non-public personal information (NPI) in accordance with the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) and applicable federal and state regulations.

Information We Collect

We may collect non-public personal information related to consumer accounts and financial receivables acquired from authorized sellers. This information may include identifying data, account-level details, and transactional records provided for lawful acquisition purposes.

How We Use Information

Information is used solely for lawful business purposes related to receivables acquisition, asset management, compliance, and legal obligations. We do not use consumer information for marketing or solicitation.

Information Sharing

Alpha Security Bureau does not sell or disclose non-public personal information to unauthorized third parties. Information may be shared only with licensed service providers, legal counsel, or regulatory authorities as permitted or required by law.

Information Security

We maintain administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect consumer information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or misuse. Security controls are aligned with our Written Information Security Program (WISP) and GLBA Safeguards Rule requirements.

Data Retention and Disposal

Consumer information is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfill business or legal obligations. When no longer required, information is securely destroyed in accordance with NIST Special Publication 800-88 standards.

Your Rights

Where applicable, individuals may have rights under federal or state law regarding access to or correction of their information. Requests are handled in accordance with applicable legal requirements.
